The Falconer Trust is a small Norfolk-based charity which supports the work of the Falconer Children's Home and Orphanage, Kabulamema, Zambia. The Home cares for about 60 children of all ages from babies to mid-teens. Neil Starling is the Trust manager, and has just returned from a visit to the Home, along with trustee Dennis Webb. Please pray for the Trust, and for the Home:

- Pray for the staff at the Home – especially Simon Samutala, the Director, his support staff Clarks, Miriam and Robbie, and the 'Mamas' who care for the children.
- Pray for the continuation of improvements at the Home, particularly the completion of accommodation building projects, extending the electrical supply to the various buildings, and resolving the difficulties around transport difficulties.
- Pray for the future of the Home, as it endeavours to meet the increasing demands of Social Welfare in terms of standards of accommodation.
- Pray for Neil and the trustees of the Falconer Trust, as they look to the future, so that support for the Home can be provided for as long as needed.
- Pray particularly for wisdom regarding the sending of parcels of goods, particularly in the face of rising costs, and the complexities of the customs process.
