



Tools With A Mission are a Christian charity that collects unwanted usable tools, refurbishes them, sorts them into trade tool kits and sends them to the developing world for livelihood creation. In doing so, they also support UK communities through volunteering opportunities and contribute significantly to environmental sustainability by reducing waste and carbon emissions in the UK. TWAM currently sends tools to communities in six countries in Africa – Zambia, Uganda, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, Malawi and DR Congo. On Saturday 23rd September WBC will be open to receive any suitable donations of tools to be collected by TWAM.
