



Tools With A Mission are a Christian charity that collects unwanted usable tools, refurbishes them, sorts them into trade tool kits and sends them to the developing world for livelihood creation. In doing so, they also support UK communities through volunteering opportunities and contribute significantly to environmental sustainability by reducing waste and carbon emissions in the UK. TWAM currently sends tools to communities in six countries in Africa – Zambia, Uganda, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, Malawi and DR Congo. On Saturday 23rd September WBC will be open to receive any suitable donations of tools to be collected by TWAM. Please pray for the work of TWAM, and those who will benefit from the tools which are sent out:

- Pray for the volunteers at the two TWAM refurbishment centres in Ipswich and Rugby, who collect, refurbish and send out the tools.
- Pray for those in Africa who receive the tools, that they may be able to develop the skills to sustain a viable livelihood, and thus be enabled to support their families and communities.
- Pray that TWAM will receive the necessary funds to maintain their premises, and to send out containers of tools to the various destinations. Pray that the deliveries of tools do not get held up by customs problems of other bureaucracy.
