Tearfund is a Christian charity that partners with churches in more than 50 of the world's poorest countries. They tackle poverty through sustainable development, responding to disasters, and challenging injustice. They believe an end to extreme poverty is possible.

- Please pray for the work of Tearfund in bringing relief to those caught up in natural disasters around the world, including the recent earthquake in Afghanistan, where the death toll had risen to over 2,400, with the number of injured being 'more than 2,000'. 1,320 houses had been either damaged or destroyed by the quake.
- Pray also for their work in Morocco, where an earthquake struck on 8<sup>th</sup> September, killing over 3,000, and affecting over 6.6 million people.
- Pray for Tearfund's Harvest Appeal, which seeks to raise funds to help those in extreme poverty to generate an income through local farming projects.
