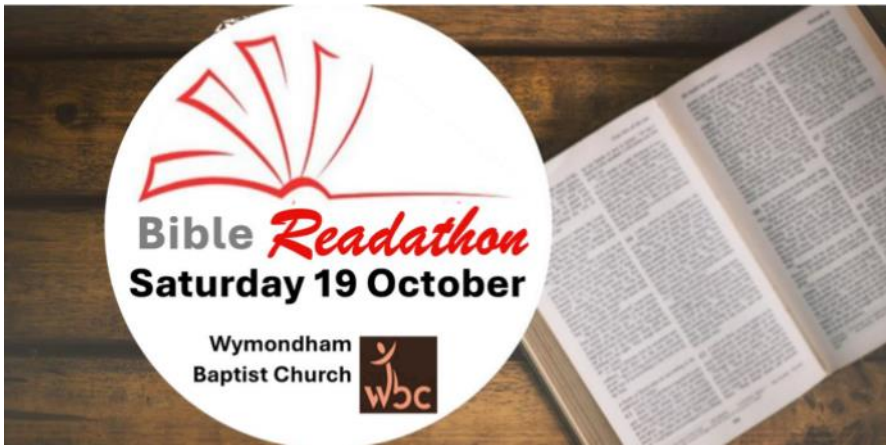
If you need to bring your dog to church, we would be grateful if you would sit in the designated area, near to the sound desk. Thank you.
